SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans 6 years & over (Eligible for BOB)

MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Brace - Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

Team - Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner. Only 4 dogs can be shown as a team, but a team may submit a 5th entry as an "alternate" team member.

Stud Dog - For Stud Dog and two or more of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

* BBE Dog, Puppy and BBE Bitch, Puppy are eligible for Best Puppy Competition

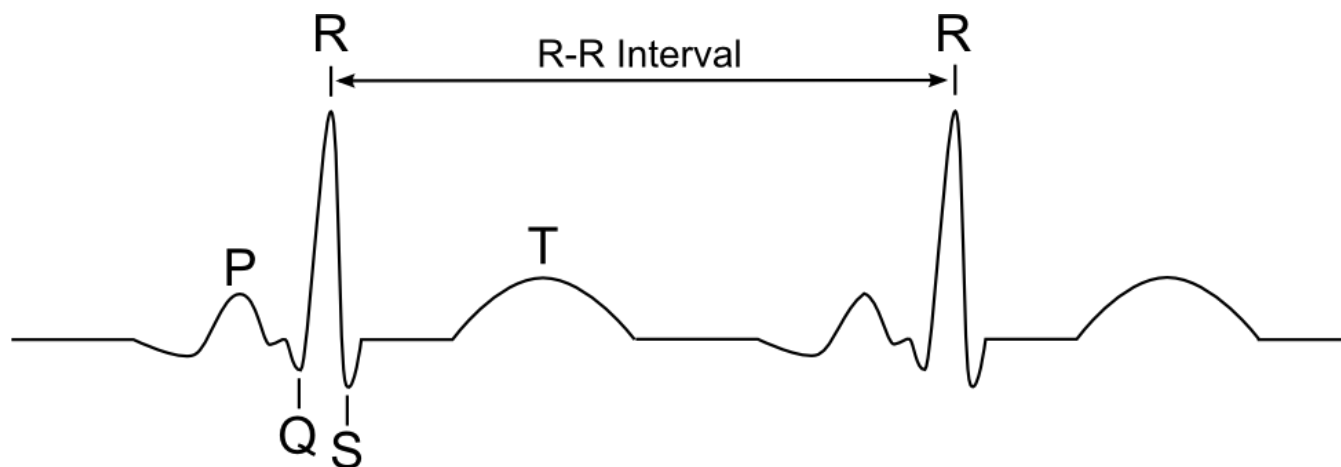

After the closing date, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON unless provided for in AKC "Rules Applying to Dog Shows".

Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable.

No Entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Errors on Entry Forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts or conditions beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show Will Be Open from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M. Sunday April 20, 2025.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Judges Are Not Required to Wait for Dogs. They will adhere as closely as practicable to the Judging Program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. IWANE and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility to provide service through a public address system or other means for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates/ex-pens except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

This event may be canceled due to extremes in weather or other conditions considered to be deleterious to the health and safety of dogs, exhibitors, judges and fanciers. No refund of entries will be made in such cases.

The show giving Club, the Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

All trophies must be claimed before the closing of the show. None will be mailed.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

The show-giving club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against IWAC or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Up to date rabies vaccination is required by the State of North Carolina.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15in.), Dachshunds (Longhaired, Smooth, Wirehaired), Bull Terriers (Colored, White), Manchester Terriers (Standard, Toy), Chihuahuas (Smooth Coat, Long Coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (Toy, Miniature, Standard), Collies (Rough, Smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.).
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
